




Founder's Day 2020

Leadership Simulator – The Origins



- FMS had a tradition of organizing trekking expeditions (1976-1985) of MBA (FT) Student Teams.
- These were part of an experiential "Leadership Simulator" exercise, created specifically to transport the conceptual education for students into real life leadership, crisis management, and decision making experiences.
- These experiences were created despite resource constraints, by actualizing an inspired dream through a combination of frugal management and partnering with supportive networks.
- Many of those who experienced these trekking expeditions benefited through their learnings during the same in later life.



Leadership Simulator – The Relaunch



- The Dean Mr. Vivek Suneja wanted this activity revived through the joint efforts of FMS Forum and MSA to assist in incubating and accelerating leadership skills in students.
- The first Leadership Simulator relaunch activity was held as an online discussion with 200 Full Time Students on 23rd October 2021 and members of the FMS Forum.
- It used as Base Case Study Material, contents from the book "Beyond the Mountains", authored by Sunder Hemrajani (Full Time Batch 1979), which is based on his experiences and learnings on leadership and decision making as a participant and Trek Leader of the 1977 and 1978 Treks.
- The event also used as input material video clips of previous trek leaders/ participants and an inspiring presentation by Dr. L. M. Johri who actually pioneered the start of the Trekking Club



Leadership Simulator: 2022 Plans



- This year's plans for the activity are under discussion.
- The conceptual framework for the exercise has been explained today.
- Video Clips of previous participants and a Case Study will be shared later in August 2022
- If the health environment permits, it is proposed to conduct a physical trek in the Indian Himalayas sometime in early October.
- An appropriate Route would need to be selected, a Trekking Team put together, and certain Roles within the Team defined.
- Funding and Resource Management would need to be looked at.
- A FMS Forum Member and a Staff Advisor would mentor the process.
- A debrief and learnings from the Trek would be held through a short session in Nov.2022


